Therefore, customers can be assured that we unbiasedly represent the best products available in today's market. Due to space limitations, the inclusion or omission of any of plant product is not reflective of the quality or service that any of our vendors provide. We stand behind all the products that we sell.

Each item in this catalog generally has multiple sources, each with their own pricing and shipping requirements. It is unfeasible to print all the pricing, along with available sizes and ordering guidelines in this edition. Supplemental information is available by request prior to placing your order. If you select various items throughout the catalog, the material may need to come from multiple sources, each with their own minimums and boxing requirements. The Plant Department will assist you in combining varieties from the various sources in order to achieve the best shipping rates and methods available.

Early ordering is the key for maximizing order fill rates. We strongly encourage booking early to have your selections custom grown for you. The average production time ranges from 5 to 12 weeks for seeds and liners. Therefore we offer "Plant Special" terms for customers with established credit. Plant Special terms are 1% net 10 or 60 days, for combined orders exceeding \$200.00 and placed thirteen or more weeks in advance of the requested ship date.

Orders placed without adequate production time will be reserved from surplus availability. Griffin's has speculation on our best selling items by having our vendors custom grow extra quantities to meet last minute ordering needs. However, for items that we do not have committed inventory on, we will access the availability of our suppliers. Many times availability can not be confirmed by the vendor until several days prior to shipping, therefore order confirmations will not be sent on availability orders. The Plant Department will attempt to reserve all of the requested material for the required ship week. It is best to allow substitutions or alternate tray sizes for maximum fill rates. Your products arrive at your door before we receive your paperwork for instant orders. If you do not receive everything you ordered, please call us immediately to re-order.

How to Order:

1. Contact the Plant Department with the varieties you are interested in. Specify your preference for vendors or ship methods. We will supply you with the current pricing and ordering requirements to build your order. A sales representative will be provided if needed, in the event that you are new to Griffin's plant products.
2. Order your materials via fax, phone, mail or e-mail, from the pricing literature provided – or – call the Plant Department to assist you with your order. (800) 732-3509
3. For advance orders, check your incoming acknowledgments and confirmations upon receipt. The acknowledgement will arrive by fax, e-mail or mail shortly after placing your order with us. A confirmation will be sent by mail when the vendor confirms that they can provide the material. Each vendor is different, and receipt times will vary. Look for any noted items that are not available, or backordered, and call Customer Service to offer a substitution, or to inform us of any discrepancies from the original order.
4. Indicate if you need tags with your orders. Patented varieties often come with tags, but for many plants it is optional.
5. Indicate any additional delivery instructions. Plants can be delivered during times that a greenhouse may be closed. Provisions must be made for a warm delivery area to drop off FedEx or UPS boxes. Griffin's can not be responsible for frozen or heat-damaged plants from other carriers!

Griffin's strives to ensure that all the products featured in the catalog are currently available. Since many vendors have not finalized their variety listing at the time of printing, some items may not be available. If given enough lead time, we can have these items custom grown for you if you meet the minimums. Griffin's cannot be held responsible for crop failures, discontinued items or shortages.

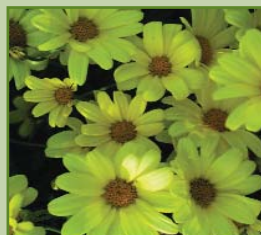

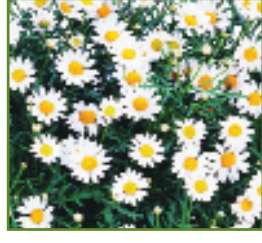

Bacopa (Sutera) Watering Requirements

Unlike most plants, sutera will not wilt when drought stressed. Before the plant shows signs of wilting it will drop both the flowers and the buds on the plant. It takes about 2 weeks for the plant to come back into bloom after it has been drought stressed. To maintain constant bloom you will either need to monitor the plant closely and water before the soil gets too dry or you could plant sutera with a plant that does wilt. Some good plants to consider are verbena, coleus, petunias etc. These companion plants will serve as indicator plants to let you know that the sutera is dry and should help you avoid having the plant dropping blooms and buds due to drought stress.

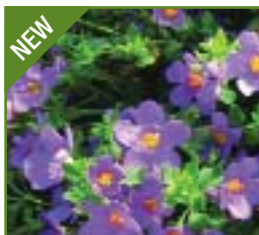
